Attached are financial statements reflecting the first three quarters of 2016.

The picture is quite similar to the one at the end of the first half, because we did not spend a lot of money in the third quarter or bring much in. Net loss for the quarter was \$69.73. The net gain for the first three quarters, however, was \$4,242.33. Our balance sheet shows \$5,167.14 available for general operating purposes.

As noted with financial statements for the first quarter and the first half, the sizeable net gain and the substantial bank balance are both attributable to grants received. Inasmuch as \$4,000 is really intended for specific grant purposes, it might be appropriate to make a mental subtraction of \$4,000 from both the net gain and the bank balance, leaving a gain in the first three quarters of \$242.33 and \$1,167.14 available for general operating purposes. We also have \$1,319.85 for development of an outdoor classroom.

Fundraising proceeds often take some time to reach us. So while not reflected on the accompanying statements, please note the following:

Produce sales looks like it will finish up at about \$270 to \$280, making this our best year yet. And it was up from just \$80 last year.

We netted \$194 in the just-completed bulb, which is our weakest result ever, but down only modestly from last year's \$227.

We will submit about \$175 worth of Boxtops for Education shortly. This is down from \$279.50 in the fall of 2015.

Contributions from individuals appear to be gaining in importance relative to other fundraising efforts. We have received \$610 so far this year from the following friends: Mike Karp, \$200; Nora Maycock, \$25; J. Leary, \$100; Crystal Heshmat, \$10; Diane Solomon, \$50; Jason Jernigan, \$50; Pat Fahy, \$50; and George Benson, \$125.

2010 -- \$2,000 grant is from Lowe's

2012 -- received about \$1,500 worth of supplies and materials from WellPoint and about \$500 in cash after returning items purchased by WellPoint. Not reflected, however, in financial statements.

2014 -- Flower Power bulb fundraiser was conducted in 2013 and 2014. All income, however, was received in 2014, due to delay in receiving check from 2013 campaign.

BoxTops have been submitted at different times of year, making comparisons difficult.

2015 -- incorporation and tax-exempt status cost \$485

2016 -- Flower Power proceeds reflect bulb sale conducted in 2015.

2016 -- received \$2,000 Whole Kids Foundation grant, \$500 Booster Club grant and \$1,500 Community Foundation grant
