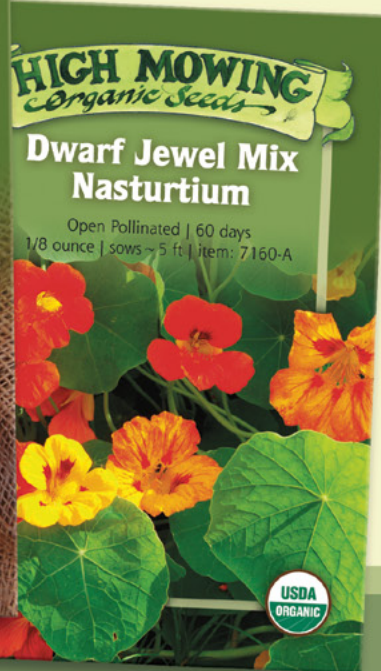
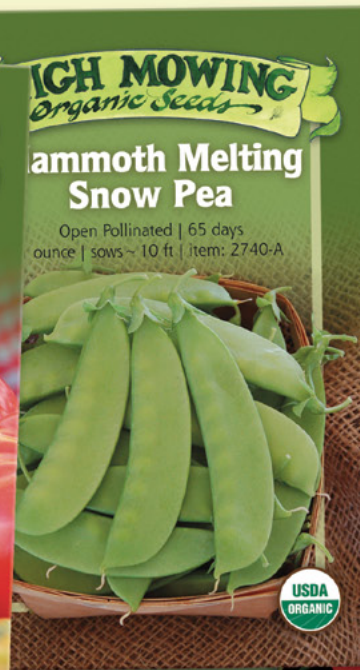
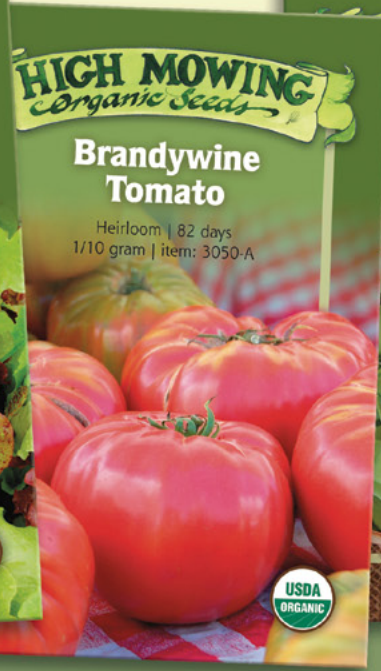

Astro Arugula A spicy, cold-hardy, salad green producing many leaves for "cut and come again" harvest. Long, dark green leaves with deeply cut lobes are very nutritious (21 days baby leaf, 40 full size; 1/32 oz; sows~12 ft)



Black Seeded Simpson Lettuce Easy to grow and quick to mature! Quickly produces a full-sized, bright green open head with slightly crinkled leaves. Withstands heat, drought, and light frost. (28 days baby, 45 full size; 1/32 oz; sows~10 ft)



Gourmet Lettuce Mix Our very own blend of red and green lettuces in a variety of leaf shapes. Grow as babyleaf or full-size leaf lettuce. (28 days baby; 1/32 oz; sows~10 ft)



High Mowing Mesclun Salad Mix Our single best selling item! A mix of babyleaf lettuce and mild and spicy mustard greens with a diversity of shapes and flavors. Cut and come again for multiple harvests. (28 days baby; 1/32 oz; sows~10 ft)



Tye Spinach Highly bolt-resistant, perfect for spring and summer sowings. Savoyed leaves grow quickly; extremely vigorous. (42 days; 1/4 oz; sows~8 ft)



Rainbow Mix Chard Brilliant shades of red, orange, pink, yellow, and white stalks are spectacular. Colors range from bold to streaked. For best color grow to full-size plants. (30 days baby leaf, 60 full size; 1/16 oz; sows~12 ft)



Red Russian Kale Sweet flavor! Distinct, bright purple stems with slate-green, deeply lobed foliage. Leaves are tender and smooth. Grow as babyleaf or full-size plants. (21 days baby, 50 full; 1/32 oz; sows~23 ft)



Cosmic Purple Carrot Deep purple skin with orange-red flesh, sweet flavor with a hint of spice. Danvers shaped roots grow to 6-7". (70 days; 1/32 oz; sows~22 ft)



De Cicco Broccoli Multi-cut heirloom variety producing compact 3-4" blue-green central heads followed by a prolific set of side shoots. Variable maturity results in a long harvest period. (48 days; 1/32 oz; sows~15 ft)



Early Wonder Beet Tall vigorous green tops with maroon veins. Quick emergence in cold soils and attractive tops make this a great early season variety for greens as well as 3" dark red globes. (20 days greens, 45 days beets; 1/16 oz; sows~8 ft)



Danvers 126 Carrot Old-fashioned carrot flavor! Sweet and crunchy roots are dark orange and great for fresh eating and soups. Large tapered roots average 6-8" long. Heat-resistant. (70 days; 1/32 oz; sows~22 ft)



Cherry Belle Radish Classic red garden radish. One inch, round radishes with a crispy white flesh and moderate heat. Will not split easily and retains quality for a long harvest period. (25 days; 1/16 oz; sows~7 ft)

Cucumber Easy to grow and high yielding! 8-9" dark green fruits remain green and crisp even under heat stress. Multiple disease resistances make it a vigorous producer all season long. (65 days; 1/16 oz; sows~14 ft)



Dark Green Zucchini

Traditional dark-green zucchini producing large quantities of nice and straight fruits that just keep coming. A reliable variety that has proven itself year after year. (50 days; 1/8 oz; sows~8 ft)



New England Pie Pumpkin

Classic New England heirloom for pies or mini jack-o-lanterns. Pumpkins range in size from 5-7 lbs. each. Creamy, stringless flesh is a rich dark-orange color. (105 days; 1/8 oz; sows~12 ft)



Green Arrow Shell Pea Main crop garden pea known for large doubly born pods with 8-11 peas each. Peas stay sweet for a long harvest window on 24-28" plants. Great for freezing! (68 days; 1 oz; sows~10 ft)



Sugar Daddy Snap Pea

Summer sweet snap peas. Medium sized vines bear early and need little support. Plants produce first-rate stringless, doubly-borne



Mammoth Melting Snow

Pea A favorite after many years! Tall vines grow 5-7' tall and bear 4-5" pods that are grown for their succulent pods, best eaten before peas begin to form. Peas come on in mid-summer. (65 days; 1 oz; sows~10 ft)



Brandywine Tomato The heirloom which sets the standard for superb tomato flavor. Large, juicy, beefsteak fruits commonly weigh over 1 lb. each with a reddish pink color and slightly ribbed. Indeterminate. (82 days; 1/10 gram)



Matt's Wild Cherry Tomato

Heavily-vining "wild" plants produce a multitude of incredibly sweet and flavorful small red fruit. Works great in hanging baskets. Indeterminate. (55 days; 1/10 gram)



Sweet Basil

Great for pesto! Traditional large-leaf variety. Tender leaves are aromatic and mild. Great for fresh use and drying. Preferred culinary variety. (65 days; 1/32 oz; sows~20 ft)



Santo Cilantro Strongly aromatic and flavorful, with a flat, parsley-like leaf, and round seeds. Both seed (coriander) and leaves (cilantro) are used in numerous cuisines from around the world. (55 days leaf, 95 seed; 1/8 oz; sows~20 ft)



Mammoth Sunflower

Towering stalks reach 7-12' with large heads that measure up to 14" across! One flower head per plant. Stalks are sturdy. Flowers follow the sun throughout the day. (110 days; 1/8 oz; sows~12 ft)



Dark Orange Calendula

Use as a bedding plant, cut flower, medicinal herb, or edible flower. Easy to grow and frost hardy. (55 days; 1/32 oz; sows~15 ft)



Dwarf Jewel Nasturtium

Compact vining habit. Brilliant red, orange, salmon, and yellow flowers boldly contrast emerald green lily pad leaves. Peppery flowers used in salads. Great for borders and containers. (60 days; 1/8 oz; sows~5 ft)
